WHO IS IT FOR?

Any Licence, minimum grade or standard required?

Diving is a skilled sport. Boroughs must ensure that they have a competent and qualified Diving Teacher and that all the competitors are able to fulfil the conditions. Jumps are NOT allowed.

SQUAD NOMINATIONS

i This is the squad you originally nominate.

Minimum: 1
Maximum: 8 (2 per event)
Alternates permitted: 2 (no new events)

TEAM ON THE DAY

i This is the team you bring to the competition.

Minimum: 1
Maximum: 4 (1 per event)

i Some competitions allow alternates. This is where you can bring a previously un-nominated competitor.

HOW DO I ENTER?

Competition Type: Secondary Open

How to enter: You will need to provide full details of your squad before the 'squad closed' date so each competitor can be checked and confirmed as eligible. Teams are submitted online. Contact your Borough Team Organiser for online access.



ABOUT THE COMPETITION

Competition Format	4 voluntary dives from at least 2 dive groups.
Draw Format	Junior Female, Junior Male, Senior Female, Senior Male.
Final Positions	Individual positions are combined to produce overall Borough points, and ranked to get an overall Borough position.
Medals	GOLD: winner, SILVER: 2nd place, BRONZE: 3rd place. Individual and Team medals awarded.

WHAT KIT & EQUIPMENT DO I NEED?

Team Manager Notes:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Boroughs must have a competent and qualified Diving Teacher All Team Managers need to complete a dive sheet on the day to indicate which dives will be performed by competitors. Team Managers and/or competitors should bring with them details of the 4 dives intended to be performed by each competitors.

SPORT SPECIFIC RULES

- The competition will be run under FINA technical rules of diving. The competition will involve the diver performing 4 voluntary dives, which must be from at least 2 different groups of dives.
- Repeat dives will be allowed. The repeat dive will be allocated a 1.0 degree of difficulty. This includes repeats from a different board or in a different position.
- Divers have the choice of diving from either the 1-metre or 3-metre springboard, or any mix of the two. Juniors are permitted one or two-bounce take-offs.
- All dives have an individual dive number as seen on the FINA DIVING DEGREES OF DIFFICULTY SHEET, e.g. Dive number 101 is a forward dive which can be performed in either a straight, piked or tucked position. The DD sheet can be viewed and downloaded from www.londonyouthgames.org/diving
- Completing Dive Sheets:
 - Dive sheets indicating the dives to be attempted must be completed and handed in to the Recorders no later than 10:30.
 - Dives may be changed up to half an hour before the commencement of each competition.
 - Dive sheets will be issued to the Team Manager at registration.
 - Assistance with completion of the dive sheets will be available.
- Please remember to:
 - Check that 4 dives (dive numbers) have been selected from at least 2 different groups (front, back, reverse, inward, twist).
 - Note the position of the dive and the board height (1m or 3m).
- Schedule:
 - 09:00 Pit available for training (only with a qualified coach in attendance). Registration opens, dive sheets available.
 - 10:30 Registration closed, dive sheets due in.
 - 11:00 Competition starts: Junior Female followed by Junior Male, Senior Female followed by Senior Male.
- Incorrect information provided during nominations can disqualify the team and cause their entire Borough team to receive penalty points. Please check competitor's details.
- INCOMPLETE COMPETITION: In the event that the competition is cancelled or suspended, the following steps will be used to calculate a final result.
 - Results from all completed events are combined and used to identify the overall winner.
 - Event types: Junior (Female), Junior (Male), Senior (Female), Senior (Male).
 - Minimum requirements: To determine a completed event, all 4 voluntary dives must take place. To determine a result for the competition, 1 event must be completed.
 - Tied teams: will not be separated once scores from events are combined, except in the event that the top 3 teams have the same number of points then the highest number of first place event finishers will be the deciding factor, then second place event finishers and so on.
 - Borough entry: If a borough has entered the competition but not an event that is used in the scoring calculation, they will be placed in last position.
- The Competition Director reserves the right to suspend/cancel the event where required by unsafe conditions. The Competition Directors decision is final.
