HOW DO I ENTER?

Competition Type: Secondary Open

How to enter: You will need to provide full details of your squad before the 'squad closed' date so each competitor can be checked and confirmed as eligible. Teams are submitted online. Contact your Borough Team Organiser for online access.



ABOUT THE COMPETITION

Competition Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The competition is a two day event.• Efforts will be made for all competitors to partake in at least 3 races.• All events will take place over the whole day in both day 1 and day 2.
Draw Format	AM and PM session.
Seeding	None
Final Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• If four or more races take place in a single event, the worst score will be discarded.• Medals will be awarded for individual events.• Best 8 finishing places across the 10 events count towards the overall borough score.
Medals	GOLD: winner, SILVER: 2nd place, BRONZE: 3rd place. Individual and Team medals awarded.

WHAT KIT & EQUIPMENT DO I NEED?

Please see the Notice Of Race for borough sail numbers.
Team Manager Notes:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure competitors have sufficient experience to be comfortable on the water, and able to handle Lee-shore landings in F5.• Please ensure competitors are wearing appropriate clothing. The Competition Director has the right to suspend participants from competing if their clothing is not appropriate.

SPORT SPECIFIC RULES

1. All sailing events will be run in accordance with the operating practices of the host venue, LYG rules, ISAF racing rules and the sailing instructions which will be issued before the event. Modifications to these may be updated at the team manager briefings.

2. The competition will involve six craft:

- A. Hansa 303
- B. Pico
- C. Feva
- D. Topper 4.2
- E. Topper
- F. Laser Radial

3. Open Gender - Competitors can be either male or female and in a 2 hander can be any gender combination.

4. Competition Events include:

Hansa 303 Open Gender:

- For training and craft supply contact sailing.principal@queenmary.org.uk
- Day 1: 2 competitors, 1 competitor in the crew to have a learning or sensory impairment
- Day 2: 2 competitors, 1 competitor in the crew to have a physical impairment

Pico

- Day 1: 2 competitors, mixed/ 1 male & 1 female alternating

Feva

- Day 2: 2 competitors, open gender

Topper 4.2

- Day 1: 1 competitor, female
- Day 2: 1 competitor, male

Topper

- Day 1: competitor, male
- Day 2: competitor, female

Laser Radial

- Day 1: 1 competitor, female
- Day 2: 1 competitor, male

5. NOTICE TO RACE: will be available when the draw is published & contain full information. Please ensure all Team Managers read this as additional rules related information is included in this document.

6. The Competitor Director reserves the right to suspend/cancel the event where required by weather/unsafe conditions.

7. Incorrect information provided during nominations can disqualify the team and cause their entire borough team to receive penalty points. Please check competitor's details.

INCOMPLETE COMPETITION: In the event that the competition is cancelled or suspended, the following steps will be used to calculate a final result.

- a. Results from all completed events are combined and used to identify the overall winner.
- b. Event types: Hansa 303 (LD/VI/II), Pico (Mxd), Topper (M), Laser (F), Topper 4.2 (F), Hansa 303 (PI), Feva, Topper (F), Laser (M), Topper 4.2 (M)
- c. Minimum requirements: To determine a completed event 1 lap of the course must take place. If there are fewer completed events than the required best 8, then all events should be counted.
- d. Tied teams: Will not be separated once scores from events are combined, except in the event that the top 3 teams have the same number of points then the highest number of first place event finishers will be the deciding factor, then second place event finishers and so on.
- e. Borough entry: If a borough has entered the competition but not an event that is used in the scoring calculation, they will be placed in last position.
