#### ABOUT THE COMPETITION

Competition Format	<ul> <li>Round robin to Knockout. Round robin points awarded are: 1 for a win, 0 for a loss.</li> <li>Each match will be one set to 25 pts, played with the standard break rules applying.</li> <li>The semi finals and the final will be best of 3 sets (the first two to 25, the deciding set if required to 15), both with standard tie break rules applying.</li> <li>Groups positions decided by: <ul> <li>a) points difference within the sets played in the groups</li> <li>b) percentage of points difference</li> <li>c) toss of a coin.</li> </ul> </li> <li>A 25 – 0 result will be given in the event of a walkover.</li> </ul>
Draw Format	Dependent on entries, the top 8 teams progress to knockout competition.
Seeding	Top 2 teams from previous year are seeded.
Final Positions	Points allocated based on knockout and group placings – all teams achieving same group position awarded equal position.
Medals	GOLD: winner, SILVER: finalist, BRONZE: 3rd= bronze.

 Team Managers are responsible for ensuring their teams are on court. Matches will be called from the registration desk or pitch.

# SPORT SPECIFIC RULES

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the FIVB rules and the English Volleyball Association.

2. The match Referee will be responsible for the conduct of each match, and any appeal against their decision must be properly recorded on the scoresheet before it is signed by Team Managers after the match.

3. A warm up will be provided before the first match, but no warm up will be given before subsequent matches.

4. Teams will only be allowed to play with less than six players in exceptional circumstances (e.g. injury) and at the discretion of the Competition Director.

5. Net height for the male competition will be 2.43 metres.

6. Incorrect information provided during nominations can disqualify the team and cause their entire Borough team to receive penalty points. Please check competitor's details.

7. INCOMPLETE COMPETITION: In the event that the competition is cancelled or suspended, the following steps will be used to calculate a final result.

a. The furthest completed stage of competition will be used to countback.

b. Any teams tied on position will be separated based on the rules above which determine group positions, using averages.

c. The minimum competition required to determine a result is a completed stage.

8. The Competition Director reserves the right to suspend/cancel the event where required by unsafe conditions. The Competition Directors decision and application of these rules is final.
