## HOW TO ENTER

**Competition Type:** Secondary Schools

**Kit & Equipment:**

- Players are strongly recommended to wear appropriate clothing including hockey-specific shin pads & gum shields.
- Players to provide own stick.
- No goalkeepers.
- An In2Hockey ball will be used.

## ABOUT THE COMPETITION

<b>Competition Format</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Points awarded are: 3 for win, 1 for a draw, 0 for a loss. Match length will be determined by number of entries.</li></ul>
<b>Draw Format</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Group stage: Round robin draw (subject to number of entries)</li><li>Knockout Stage (QF, SF, Final)</li></ul>
<b>Seeding</b>	None
<b>Final Positions</b>	Points allocated based on final positions and group placings – all teams achieving same group position awarded equal position.
<b>Medals</b>	GOLD: winner, SILVER: finalist, BRONZE: 3rd place.

## SPORT SPECIFIC RULES

- The competition shall be played according to the Rules of 6-a-side In2Hockey with full sized goals.
  - Please find a copy of England Hockey's In2 Rules available to download at <https://www.londonyouthgames.org/sports/hockey/in2hockey-y7/>
- Matches are played on synthetic turf pitches marked out for In2Hockey.
- QUALIFIERS:
  - Groups decided by: points accrued, goal difference, goals for, 1 vs 1 penalty shuffles from the half way line (10 seconds for the attacker to score a goal from 3 metres outside the circle against 1 defender)
- KNOCKOUT STAGE:
  - In the event of a draw, the game will be decided by a penalty shuffle competition. The winning team is the team with the most goals after three players have had their turn.
  - In the event of a tie then the same players will repeat the process on a sudden death basis.
- UMPIRES: Umpires and officials for all competitions will be provided through the East and South Region Young Umpires Programme for 14-20 year olds where available.
- The Competition Director reserves the right to suspend/cancel the event where required by weather/unsafe conditions. Interpretations and guidance on all Hockey rules shall be provided by the Competition Director and the decisions of the Competition Director are final.
