

Teams can be nominated, with encouragement for the team to have training prior to the County competition Teams can qualify via an Intra School competition. 		
Sitting Volleyball (Y56)	Development	Inclusive team composition – including both participants categorised as SEND and non-SEND. Participants will train and compete together.	 Purpose of competition is to engage new or novice participants to the sport and promote confidence. Teams can be nominated, with encouragement for the team to have training prior to the County competition Teams can qualify via an Intra School competition. 		
Boccia (Y6&U)	Performance	Targeted team composition – SEND participants only. Teams must involve players with; o severe learning disabilities o severe physical impairments o profound / multiple impairments (particularly wheelchair users)	 Purpose of competition is performance-based catering for the most talented athletes and teams. Teams can qualify via an Intra School competition.

MLD Tennis (Y7-9)	Performance	Targeted team composition – SEND participants only. Teams must involve players with; o Moderate Learning Disabilities.	 Purpose of competition is performance-based catering for the most talented athletes and teams. Teams can qualify via an Intra School competition. SGOs should contact their local projectability lead for local intra school qualifiers.
Inclusive Cricket (Y78)	Performance	Inclusive team composition – including both participants categorised as SEND and non-SEND. Participants will train and compete together. Non-SEND players selected are encouraged to be those not frequently selected for school teams.	 Purpose of competition is performance-based catering for the most talented athletes and teams. Teams can qualify via an Intra School competition.
Inclusive Fanfest (Primary)	Festival	Inclusive classes – including both participants categorised as SEND and non-SEND. Participants will train and compete together. More specific information will be provided when entries are open.	 No links directed from local intra school competitions. Nomination from an SGO to provide an opportunity for pupils to participate and represent their school at a County Festival with a less competitive format.
