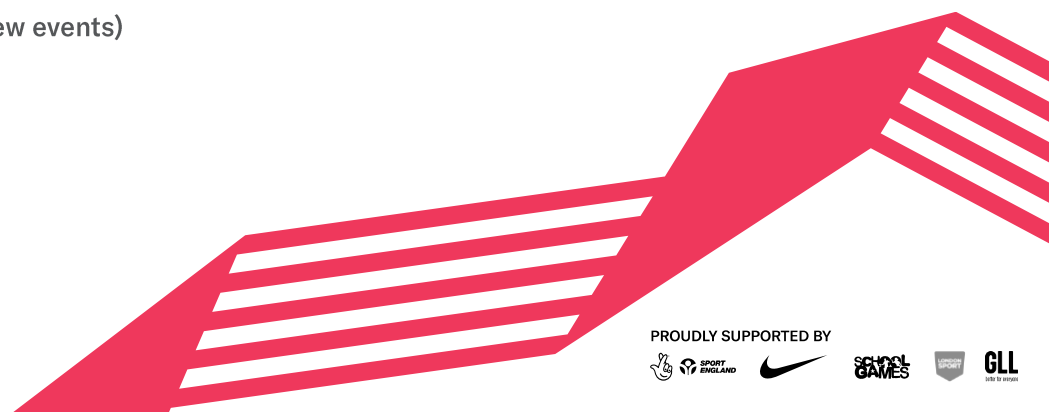

About the competition

Competition Format: Chip timing will be used.

Seeding: No seeding.

- Final Positions:**
- All events are scoring.
 - Overall team positions are determined by total points scored over the **best 3 event results**.
 - The Positions of the borough's first 3 finishers in each event is used to create the team's event ranking. This ranking is then converted to a score using the LYG points (i.e. 50 for 1st place) to create an event score for each borough. The borough's scores are then combined to determine their overall finishing position.
 - **New for 2020 - Incomplete teams (teams with less than 3 runners) will be eligible for event points. The scoring will be calculated;**
 - Teams with 2 runners: points will equal the finishing position of the two runners + the final position
 - Teams with 1 runner: points will equal the finishing position of the one runner + the two final positions
 - In the event of a tie for overall Borough **medal** positions, the highest placed 4th scoring event shall determine the result.
- Medals:**
- Medals awarded for Individual runners and Team Event runners.
 - Trophy awarded to Borough Champions.

What kit and equipment do I need?

- Kit & Equipment:**
- Race numbers must be worn on chest at all times, pinned in four corners.
 - Chip affixed around the ankle.
 - Number, pins and chip for each runner will be distributed to the TM during registration.
 - Spikes are advisable but not essential (see rule 3)

- Team Manager Notes:**
- Briefing at 10.15 by the bandstand.

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Sport Specific Rules

- 1) The Competition Director reserves the right to suspend/ cancel the event where required by weather/ unsafe conditions.
- 2) The event will be run in accordance with UKA and ECCA Rules (<http://www.uka.org.uk/competitions/rules/>). The decision of the Referee will be final on the application of those rules.
- 3) **RACE RULES**
 - Runners must wear appropriate footwear to the course which is mainly grassland. Spikes or studs are advisable (length dependant on the ground conditions).
 - Event runner must wear the race number and chip allocated.
 - All runners must assemble in the Start Collection Area 10 minutes before the advertised time of their race. Runners should remain clothed until 5 minutes before their race.
 - Runners must follow the direction of the Race Marshals. Runners not completing the course will be disqualified.
- 4) **PROPOSED SCHEDULE**
 - 09.00-10.00 Arrival and Registration (Borough Team Organiser or Team Manager will register the team; individuals do not register)
 - 10.15 Team Manager briefing
 - Timings of events will be released after the draw has taken place.
 - Distances are as follows:
 - Event 2 - 3000m
 - Event 4 - 1500m
 - Event 6 - 2000m
 - Event 8 - 4500m
- 5) **LYG REMINDERS**
 - LYG will not distribute competitor T shirts.
 - Incorrect information provided during nominations can disqualify the team and cause their entire Borough team to receive penalty points. Please check competitor's details.
