Changing Rooms: There are no changing rooms available. Please come dressed ready for the activity you are participating in.

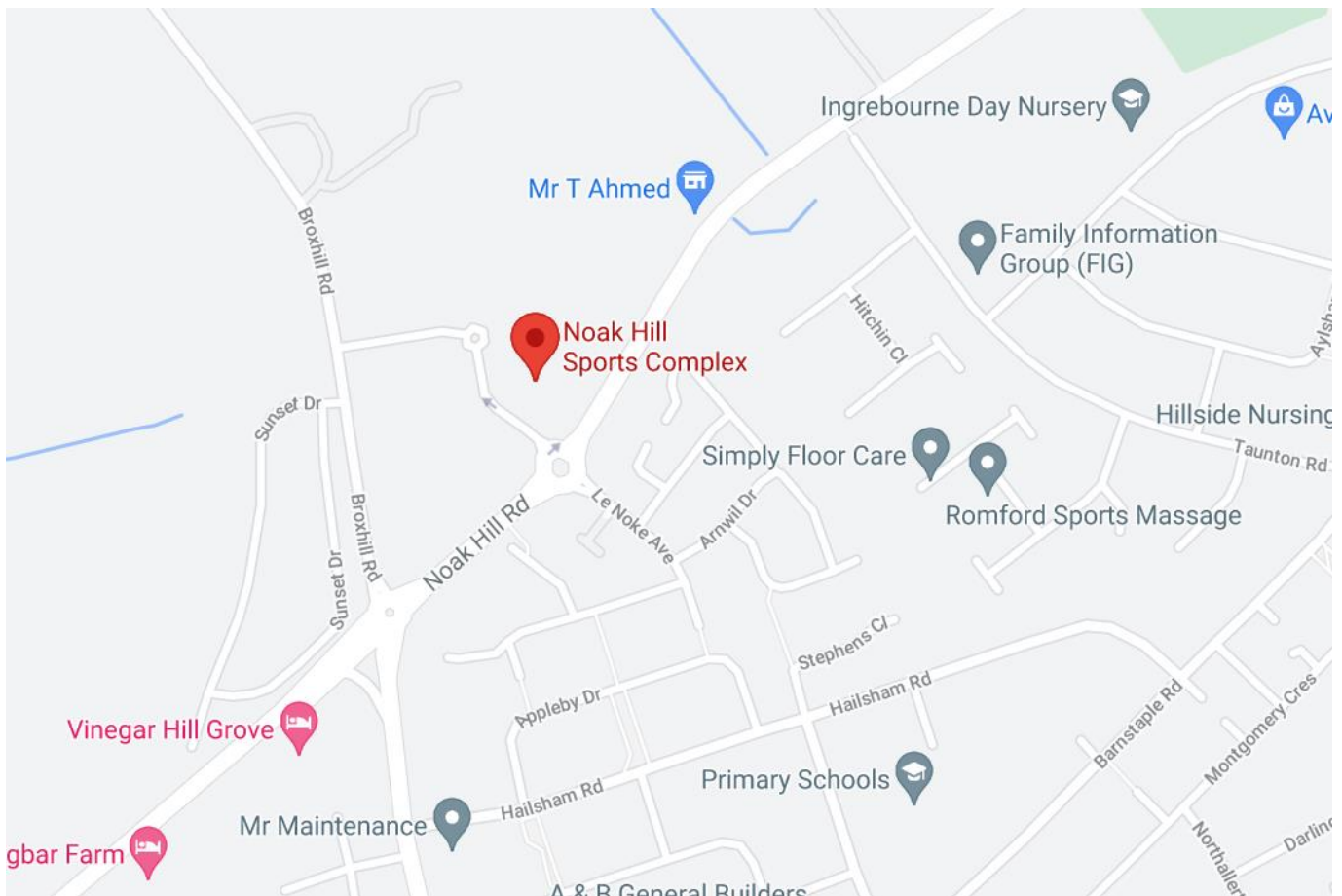
Disabled Facilities: There are 10 disabled parking spaces and unisex accessible toilets in reception and by the entrance to the sports hall.



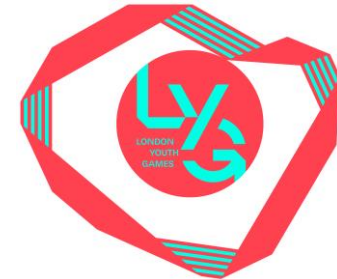
TRANSPORT INFORMATION

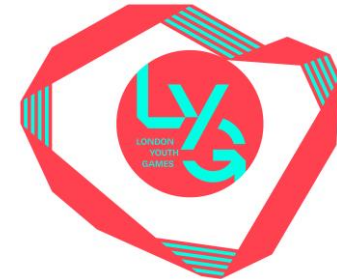


- London Youth Games Foundation will be run with the following Principles of Participation in mind.
