



#### **INCOMPLETE COMPETITION:**

If the competition is cancelled or suspended, the following steps will be used to calculate a final result.

- a) Results from all completed events are combined and used to identify the overall winner.
- b) Event types: Hansa 303 (LD/VI/HI), Pico (mixed), Topper (M), Laser (F), Topper 4.2 (F), Hansa (PI), Feva, Topper (F), Laser (M), Topper 4.2 (M).
- c) Minimum requirements: To determine a completed event 1 lap of the course must take place. If there are fewer completed events than the required best 8 then all events should be counted.
- d) Tied teams: will not be separated once scores from events are combined, except in the event that the top 3 teams have the same number of points then the highest number of first place event finishers will be the deciding factor, then the second-place event.
