

 WILL NOT be accepted in any circumstances.


RESPECT THE GAMES


- Anyone involved in the games must be made aware of the LYG Code of Conduct and agree to abide by the principles. A breach in the code may jeopardise involvement in the games.





TRANSPORT INFORMATION

Team parking:

Please use the car park situated at the Jack Carter Pavilion (as seen in photo below). This can be accessed by driving through the car park at Redbridge Sports Centre. When you are parking in this area (yellow box on picture below) **only**, it is free of charge. Please note, parking is limited and will be on a first-come-first served basis. We strongly recommend dropping off where possible.



If there is no available space in the car park at the Jack Carter Pavilion, you can use the Redbridge Sports Centre car park but please note you **must** pay and display. Up to 3 hours £1; up to 6 hours £2; up to 9 hours £8 and all day is £15 on weekdays.

It is free drop off for up to 20 minutes in Redbridge Sports Centre's car park but you will be fined if you stay any longer, so please make sure to pay if you do.







Payment for parking can be made through app, phone or at reception via a tablet using a debit/ credit card.

Once the car park is full, please use alternative carparks suggested below:

OFF -SITE PARKING

Additional parking spaces if the above car parks are full. (Pay and display only)

- D. Fairlop Station Car Park
- E. Craven Gardens Car Park
- F. *Newbury Park Station (IG2 7RN; Not shown on Map)

*You can park at Newbury Park Station on the Central Line and take tube to Fairlop Station (2 stops) and a two minute walk to Redbridge Sports & Leisure Centre

Note: Craven Gardens has a height restriction and is not suitable for minibuses.

Tubes and Trains: Closest station is Fairlop (Central line) which is right next to the venue.

Buses: 462 (use Fairlop Station stop)

We strongly recommend the use of public transport to get to the event.
