



Equipment:

- All riders are required to have BCF third party liability insurance (£1.50 cost). BCF members
 are free (membership number must be provided on the entry form)
- o All competitors must wear protective head gear whilst on the course.
- Riders must use their own bikes. LYG will not provide bikes
- Specialised Time Trial Bikes are not allowed
- Cameras must not be worn by riders nor can they be attached to any equipment.
- Any bikes that do not comply with British Cycling regulations will be subject to approval or rejection by the commissaire on the day
- All bikes must have efficient brakes and be in road worthy condition
- Please refer to British Cycling regulations on equipment and gears (found here)
- Team Size:
 - o Minimum 1, maximum 16
 - (AB male = 3, AB female = 3, CDE male = 3, CDE female = 3, RR male=2, RR female=2)
 - No alternates allowed (registered reserves can be used to replace any nominated riders)
- Photo Consent: There will be photograpahers at this event, as well as a media team from London Sport. Please check your competitors and their parents/guardians have provided this consent. Please advise when registering of any competitors who do not have/given this consent.





Spectator Parking: None available at venue. Recommend use of public transport, or public parking at Here East. Please see map below.


