ABOUT THE VENUE

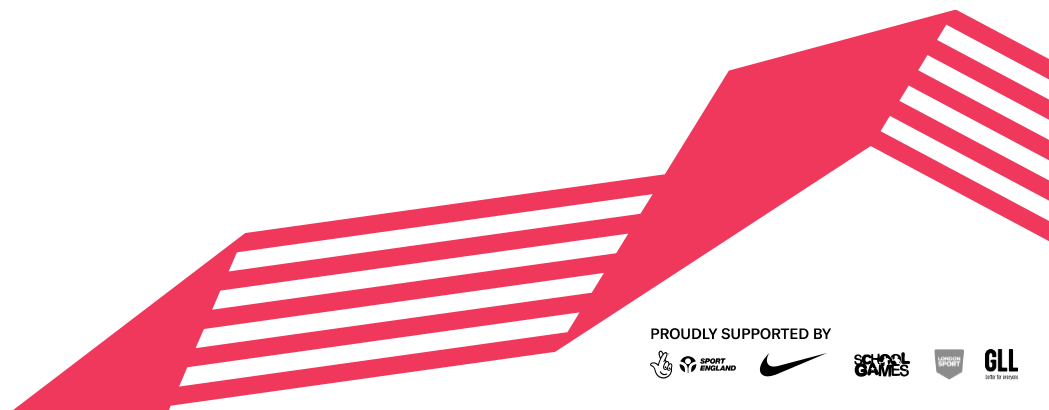
Catering: There is no café at centre. Please make sure you bring your own refreshments with you. There is a coffee cart that bases itself by the tennis courts.
