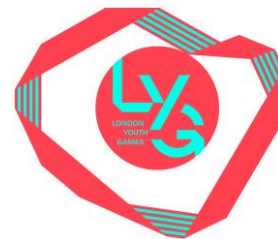

Finals Schedule & Format

Four pitches will be in use across the two full-sized hockey pitches at the centre. Every team will be guaranteed at least one match on the Olympic pitch.

Each gender will be split into two pools, playing three round robin matches within their pool. Each pool will consist of two 1st place pool winners and two runners up from qualifiers, drawn at random.

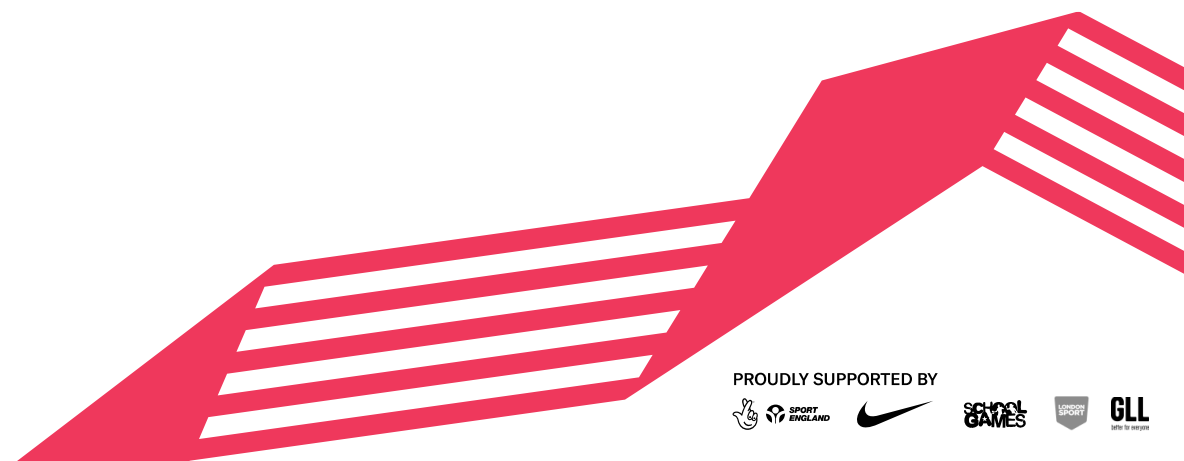

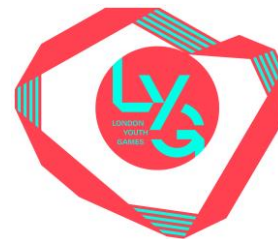
- London Youth Games Foundation will be run with the following Principles of Participation in mind.
