  - Squad Size: 12 per age category and gender (96 total)
  - Alternates: Each Borough is permitted TWO substitutions, per gender (4 total).
     Additional/late entries will not be accepted, and substitutions must be in the same age and gender as the original entry. All substitution details must be provided at registration on the day of the event.

#### Kit & Equipment:

o Competitors should wear appropriate attire and footwear suitable for the terrain and conditions the competition will be run on/in. The terrain is largely grassland (please see guidance on ticks here), with areas of uneven ground and potentially slippery conditions,

and therefore **spikes are advised**, but not compulsory. All competitors should be aware that other competitors may be wearing spikes.

- Timing and Numbers All competitors will be provided with a timing chip, and race number/bib that can be collected from their Team Manager.
  - Race numbers/bibs must be secured to the front of a competitors clothing, below the chest and above the waist area. This must be secured on all four corners – any competitors without fully secured numbers/bubs may be prevented from competing.
  - Timing chips must be securely fastened to a competitor's ankle, ensuring the strap passes through the slot provided. Timing chips worn elsewhere on a competitor's body may result in a void/incomplete result.

### Results:

• All results will be published live during each event. please ensure you scan the QR code posted around the event to keep up to date.

• Post event - results will be available to download on the competition webpage within 24 hours of the competition ending. see the <u>games rules</u> rule 23.1 for further information on disputes.

• Queries on individual results can be raised in writing up to 24 hours after results have been published.

• In the event of a competition appeal, the use of external video footage and/or photographs <u>will not</u> be accepted in any circumstances.
