 - **Squad Size:** Schools are permitted to bring a minimum of 5 competitors and a maximum of 12 competitors per gender.
 - **Competition rules:** four quarters of 10 minutes running clock with a seven-minute half-time break with a two-minute interval between 1st and 2nd quarters and the 3rd and 4th quarters.
- **Kit & Equipment:** Each school must provide two contrasting set of numbered bibs. No t-shirts to be worn under numbered shirts.
