



LYG Team Managers – Code of Conduct

As a person of responsibility taking part in London Youth Games competitions and events, I agree and abide by the principles detailed in this code of conduct.

Responsibility

- I will have clear understanding of who is in my care, and I will obtain the necessary consents for them to participate.
- I will respond to any concerns about a young person's welfare and report any concerns as appropriate to LYG Staff.
- I will remain present on site throughout the event and ensure all participants are supervised.
- I will not knowingly select a participant with an injury or is unfit to participate.
- I will not engage in inappropriate physical contact, use abusive language, physical violence, or condone bullying behaviour.
- I will not consume any illegal substances, alcohol or smoke at London Youth Games competitions and events.
- I will not engage in abuse online or on social media.
- I will ensure I have the appropriate qualifications and compliance documentations for my sport or physical activity and meet LYG requirements.

Fair Play

- I will always treat people with respect and appreciate that all participants and those engaged with LYG bring something valuable to the games.
- I will ensure my participants compete according to the rules of the sport / activity and the London Youth Games competition or event rules.
- I will respect all officials and event organisers and their decisions.
- I will fully uphold the compliance and safeguarding policies & procedures for my sport / physical activity and London Youth Games.

Equity and Inclusiveness

- I will value and respect the diversity of people, respecting the differences in gender, disability, culture race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, and religious belief systems.
- I will not tolerate or be involved with discrimination of any kind, and I will report any incidents that I witness or am aware of.



- I will respect young people's opinion when making decisions about their participation in sport and physical activity.

I understand that if I breach this code of conduct, the concerns will be followed up with the Borough Team Organiser, Local Authority Designated Safeguarding Officer and /or relevant officer at the NGB or Organisational Board for the sport or activity.

Low level breaches will carry a yellow card offence, meaning that any further breaches will result in a red card offence whereby the individual will be removed from all London Youth Games competitions and/or events and the borough team will be disqualified with a points penalty.

Severe breaches will result in an immediate red card offence, whereby the individual will be removed from all London Youth Games competitions and/or events and the borough team will be disqualified with a points penalty.
