



For the 2025/26 season, we have three categories of roles available to apply for:



Attend LYG events as an LYG33 ambassador, supporting the delivery of and getting behind the scenes experience at events. Connecting with the Borough Team Organisers and/or School Games Organiser in your borough to develop opportunities in your community. Attend additional optional events as an LYG33 ambassador e.g. conferences, summits, youth connection sessions. Work with teammates to identify further ways in which LYG33 can positively impact young Londoners. 	
Skills Required	 Passionate about youth voice representation and using the power of competitive sport to create life changing opportunities for all young Londoners. Willingness to develop yourself and work collaboratively with teammates. Ability to manage your time and balance workload.
